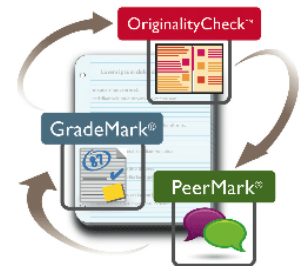
What's Turnitin?

Turnitin: An online plagiarism prevention system and a complete web-based class management solution.

Turnitin is part of a comprehensive solution, called WriteCycle, that allows educators and students to assess and grade student work via the internet.

WriteCycle is a suite of tools:

- Originality Report – Turnitin plagiarism detection (plagiarism prevention module)
- PeerMark – students peer reviewing each others' work
- GradeMark – online grading and ability to data-mine information

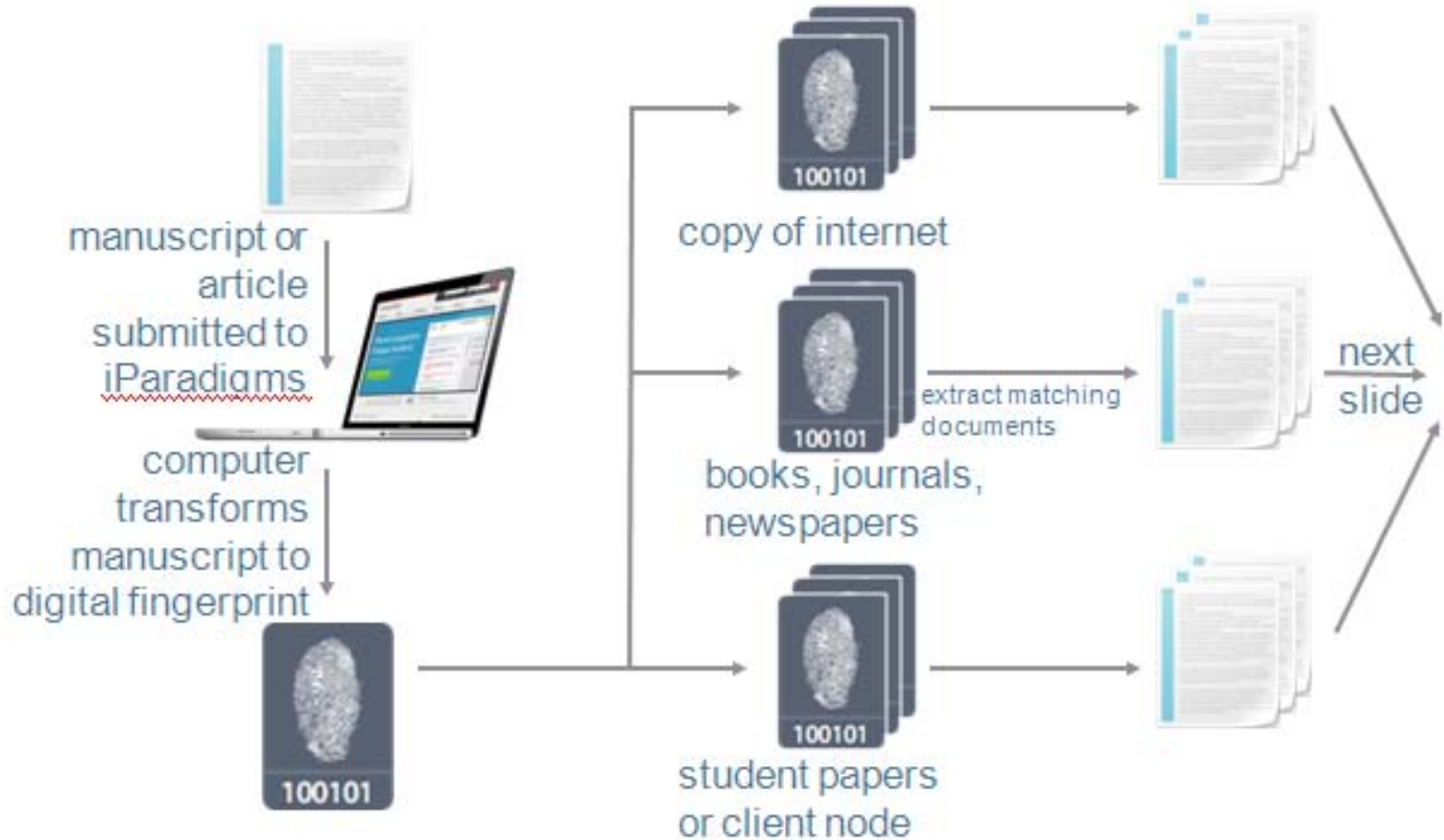

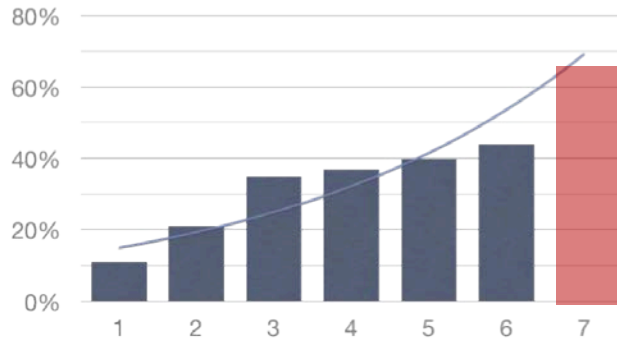

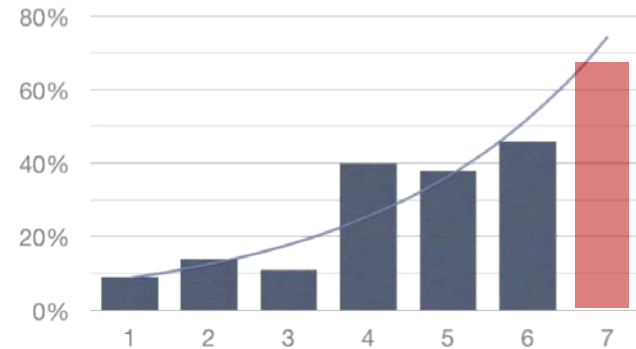
■ Percent improvement compared to first full academic year — Trend

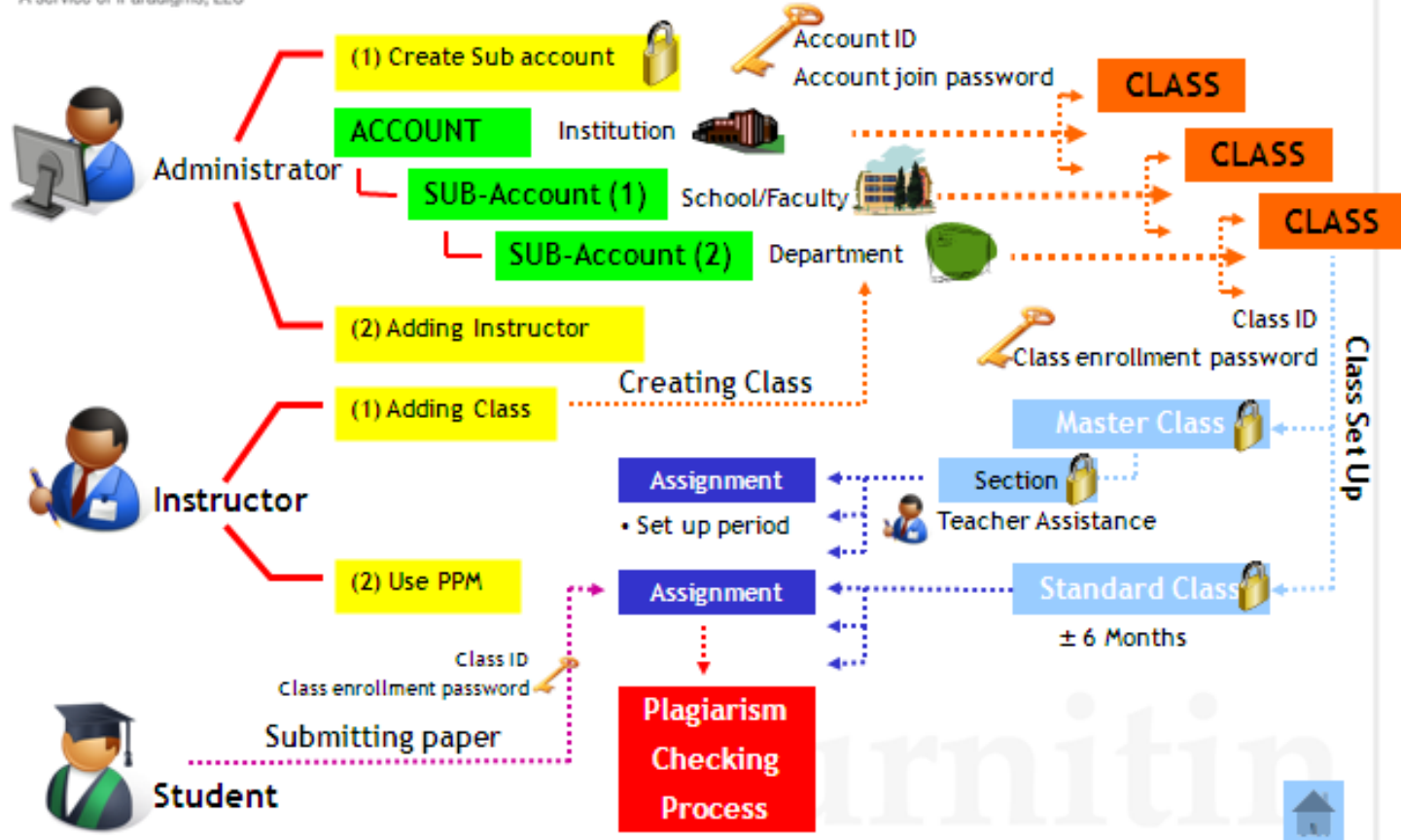
■ Percent improvement compared to first full academic year — Trend
